

Mandt Moment

In Mandt training, we discuss the importance of language and choosing our words carefully with individuals on a daily basis. Below you will find the piece "Greg's Glasses".

Greg's Glasses

Greg was 35 and had Down's Syndrome. Short and stocky in appearance, he lived in a group home and worked as a bus boy at a local restaurant. There he sometimes had a tough time. The other bus boys and waiters would play practical jokes on him, put funny hats on him and generally made him a butt of their humor. One of their favorite jollies was to point out a sign and tell him it said he was supposed to do something. You know, like go over to the local lumberyard and ask for a plank stretcher. Greg, always trusting and eager to please, inevitably fell for these ruses, to the general hilarity of all. The pranks would invariably end in Greg's confusion and embarrassment.

You see, Greg couldn't read. This was one of the great sorrows in his life. Lots of effort had been put into helping him to acquire this skill, but no matter how hard he tried he just couldn't get it. One day, I received a call from the group home. "Something is wrong with Greg. He's angry; he won't talk. And besides that, he just got a new pair of glasses and he had them only about 10 minutes before he threw them on the ground and stomped on them." That didn't sound like Greg.

"Bring him over," I said. When Greg arrived, he slumped in the big chair in my office. He hadn't given me his usual enthusiastic greeting. Clearly, he was ticked off. After trying to engage him I finally said, "I hear you broke your glasses." "Yeah," he nodded. "But you are wearing your glasses," I said. "Old glasses," he explained. "Oh," I said, "These are your old glasses. The others were different?" He nodded. "So why did you break them?" I asked. "Didn't work," he said. Gradually the story came out. They were getting him new glasses. He had been looking forward to them. More than just looking forward to them, he had been positively excited about them. He had been counting down the days until they arrived. It was like waiting for Christmas. They were to be bifocals, you see. But they hadn't called them "bifocals." No, they told him he was getting "reading glasses".

Get it? Reading glasses. So, when his glasses arrived, the first thing he did was put them on and grab a newspaper. And do you know what? He still couldn't read. They didn't work. It was just another deception. In his rage and disappointment, he threw them on the floor and smashed them. Ah, yes, words have living power. They have the power to heal, to persuade, to wound or deceive. But English is a funny language, full of nuances and pitfalls. Maybe that's why we so often have to ask, "You know what I mean?"
