A light jacket, A hat Sunscreen, Lots of water, Comfortable weather appropriate shoes

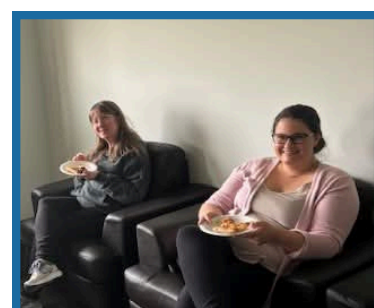
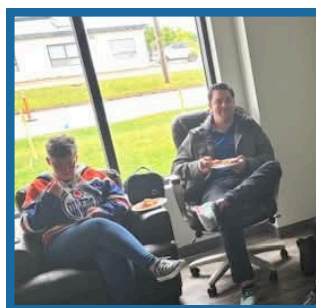

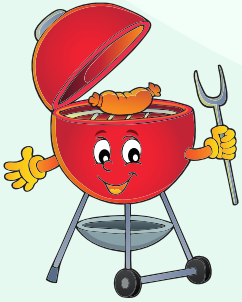
1. **What is your favourite book?** My favourite book is my Goodnight Book, I like reading at night, it helps me sleep.

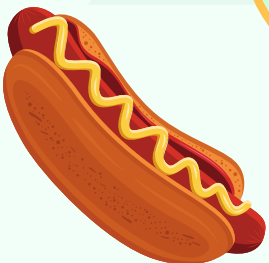
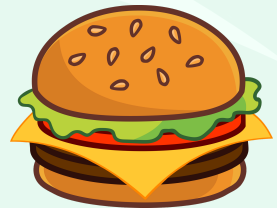
